OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Restoration of commuted portion of pension implementation of the judgement of the Supreme Court - clarification regarding.

The undersigned is directed to say that a number of communications have been received from individual pensioners, Associations of pensioners etc. seeking clarification regarding restoration of commuted portion of pension in terms of this Departments O.M.No.34/2/86-P&PW dated 5.3.87. The points raised are clarified below:-

- | Points | Decision/clarification |

| 1. Whether the O.M. is applicable to All India Services Officers. | Yes. The O.M. is applicable to all categories of pensioners as indicated in para 2 thereof and no separate orders will be issued. |
| 2. Whether the O.M. is applicable to only those pensioners who commute their portion of pension on or after 1.4.85. | No. The O.M. is applicable to all pensioners irrespective of their date of retirement provided they have commuted a portion of pension and have completed/will complete 15 years of retirement before, on or after 1.4.85 i.e. the date from which restoration has been allowed. |
| 3. Date from which commuted pension is to be restored where period of 15 years of retirement is already over before 1.4.1985. | 1.4.1985 |
| 4. Date from which commuted pension will be restored where 15 years period after retirement is over on or after 31.3.1985. | 1.4.1985 or thereafter as and when due after completion of 15 years from the respective date(s) of retirement. |


