I am directed to say that it has been decided to enhance the basic monthly pension of freedom fighters and the basic monthly dependent family pension of spouses (widows/widowers) of deceased freedom fighters by Rs.2,330/- per month with effect from 02.10,2006. Consequently, the monthly basic pension of various categories of freedom fighters and spouses of deceased freedom fighters will be as below with effect from 02.10.2006: -

You are, therefore, requested to issue necessary instructions to all concerned to modify the existing Pension Payment Orders (PPOs) of the freedom fighter pensioners and the eligible dependent spouses (widows/widowers) pensioners of deceased freedom fighters, in each case, to effect revision of monthly basic pension as indicated above.
- 3. Other terms and conditions of the sanctions will remain unaltered.
